THE ORCHESTRA

Moreton Bay Symphony Orchestra (MBSO) is a community orchestra based in the Moreton Bay Region, Queensland. MBSO performs a wide variety of music ranging from contemporary, popular, and classical music through to large scale symphonies. MBSO is made up of members coming from all walks of life: working professionals, musicians, music educators, students and retirees. Members are brought together under the musical direction of Bronwyn Gibbs.

THE SCHOLARSHIPS

Moreton Bay Symphony Orchestra is providing scholarships that are open to players from primary school age to 25 years. A successful applicant will have a minimum AMEB Grade 4 standard in their chosen instrument for the MBSO Youth Symphony, and/or minimum AMEB Grade 5 standard in their chosen instrument if they wish to also play in MBSO. If you fit this category, and play either Bass Clarinet, Trumpet, Trombone, Bassoon or Tuba, you are invited to apply. The available scholarships include paid membership and free instrument hire (Tuba and Bass Clarinet) for one year.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

The prospective scholarship recipient must attach this completed form to an email and send it to MBSO's email address: enquiries@mbso.org.au. You will be notified within 5-7 working days whether you have been accepted for an audition. An audition will take place at the earliest convenience for both the selection panel and the potential recipient. You will be contacted either via telephone or email once auditions have been completed with the outcome of your application.

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance is required for at least 75% of rehearsals and all concerts. An MBSO scholarship is a full-time commitment for the entire year. Absentees must notify the president or another committee member in advance. Concert dates are listed below so it is essential that you organise your other commitments around these dates:
